Dear Year 7 Parent/ Guardian

Year 7 Progress Tests (18th June-22nd June 2018)

I am writing to let you know that after half-term all Year 7 students will be completing progress tests in the majority of their subjects. These tests will cover all the topics which they have studied so far this year. They will take place in their normal lessons and most of the tests will happen in the week beginning Monday 18th June. Some students will also have tests in one or two of their lessons in the following week.

We are currently organising the timetable for these tests to ensure that they do not have too many tests each day. Each student will be provided with a blank progress test timetable which will be stuck in the front of their planners. Their class teachers will tell them when their test will take place and they will be required to complete this on their timetable sheet. This will be completed over the next couple of weeks.

Your child will also be given a booklet in tutor time which provides further details about these tests. It will include:

- topics which your child should revise in preparation for the tests
- some top tips on how to revise
